"Grist from the Mill"

In 1792, 15 churches located in Caroline, Goochland, Hanover, Louisa, Orange, and Spotsylvania counties came together to form the Association of churches that we call the Goshen. The driving reasons for their action were to provide fellowship for the churches and members who were a religious minority among the

ministers and to evangelize the lost who surrounded them.

Things have changed a great deal over the past 224 years. A non-Baptist commented to me that in our area "Baptists are as thick as thieves." I did not ask if he referred to our numbers, moral qualities, or increasing girth, but the fact remains, Baptists are no longer a troubled minority. Numerous schools and education opportunities are available to learn about Baptist doctrine, polity, and history. But,

one issue remains unchanged, we are still surrounded by the lost.

In everything we do as an Association one motivation is constant. People need to hear the Good News brought by Jesus. It is why we send people to do a retreat in Romania. It is why we bring people to work on homes during Impact VA! It is why we created the RuraLove Ministry, raise funds for Stop Hunger Now and provide financial support for church planters across the globe.

Notice this. For 224 years the Goshen has existed to spread the Gospel by any means that gave us the opportunity to do so. It might take the blistered hands of a teenager or weeping with someone in sorrow before we will be heard, but our message remains. We are here, serving, helping, guiding, and loving because we are the graced of God, called and blessed to share His grace with those who need Him.
